EMPTY TOMB CRAFT

Help your child build an empty tomb to show that Jesus has risen!

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- 2 Sheets of white paper
- Crayons or markers
- Scissors
- Tape or glue
- Popsicle stick (or substitute such as a plastic spoon)

STEPS

- 1. Get one white sheet of paper and draw a simple tomb with a door on it (as seen in the diagram below).
- 2. Take a cup, and place it upside down on the other sheet of paper. Trace around the cup to make a circle, and cut the circle out be the tomb door.
- 3. Tape or glue the circle onto the end of a popsicle stick (view diagram for specifics).
- 4. Cut two slits to the side of the tomb door (as seen in the diagram below).
- 5. Slide the popsicle stick (or substitute) through the slits to cover the opening of the tomb with the stone.
- 6. Have your child color the tomb (if desired).
- 7. Have your child roll the stone away by pulling on the popsicle stick and say, "The tomb is empty! Jesus is alive!"
