EMPTY TOMB CRAFT

Help your child build an empty tomb to show that Jesus has risen!

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- 2 Sheets of white paper
- Crayons or markers
- Scissors
- Tape or glue
- Popsicle stick (or substitute such as a plastic spoon)

STEPS

1. Get one white sheet of paper and draw a simple tomb with a door on it (as seen in the diagram below).
2. Take a cup, and place it upside down on the other sheet of paper. Trace around the cup to make a circle, and cut the circle out to be the tomb door.
3. Tape or glue the circle onto the end of a popsicle stick (view diagram for specifics).
4. Cut two slits to the side of the tomb door (as seen in the diagram below).
5. Slide the popsicle stick (or substitute) through the slits to cover the opening of the tomb with the stone.
6. Have your child color the tomb (if desired).
7. Have your child roll the stone away by pulling on the popsicle stick and say, "The tomb is empty! Jesus is alive!"
