MEMORY VERSE CARDS

Print out two copies of the memory verse card document, and cut out each picture. (There should be two of each picture.) Mix up the pictures, place them all face down, and play a memory matching game with your child. The first player turns two cards face up. If the cards match, they remove them from the game and get to keep them. If they do not match, they flip them face down again. Continue taking turns with your child until all the cards are picked up. Then, take the cards, and put them in the correct order together! Go over the memory verse. Mix the cards up again and repeat the memory verse matching game as long as your child is interested.

No printer option: Show your child each picture and say the words associated with the picture as a review! Once you have done this a few times, flip through the pictures and see if they can tell you what each picture means. Consider offering a reward if they can get them all right!
