



BIBLE LESSON

LACCHEAUS - WEEK 1

- **1. Memory Verse:** Show your kids the <u>memory verse pictures</u>, and point to each picture as you say the associated words. Have your child repeat the words back to you as you point to each picture. Do this a few times!

ACTIVITY 1

STICK PUPPETS

Print out the <u>stick puppet document</u>, and cut out the little people. Glue popsicle sticks (or a comparable object like a stick or plastic spoon) to the back of the cut-out people to make stick puppets! If you'd like, you can also print out the background page to have a small scene for your puppets. Act out this week's story of Jesus and the children with your puppet people!



ACTIVITY 2

CRAFT

Help your child make a sycamore tree for Zacchaeus to climb!

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Brown or white paper
- Leaves page (optional)
- Pen or marker
- Tape or glue
- Scissors



STEPS

- 1. Trace your child's hand and arm on a piece of paper with a pen or marker to form a tree. Color the tree brown.
- 2.Help your child cut along the traced outline to cut out the tree.
- 3. Print out or draw simple leaves to tape or glue to your tree branches. Color the leaves green.
- 4.Get your Zaccheaus stick puppet from activity 1, and have Zaccheaus climb the tree!

ACTIVITY 3

GOD'S ANIMAL - THE PANDA

This week's animal is the panda bear! Show the <u>"God's Animal - The Panda"</u> page to your child, and read with your child about the panda and how they are a kind animal!



THE PANDA

This is a panda bear! A panda is a type of bear that has black and white fur. Panda bears are sometimes called giant panda bears because of how big they are. They are very tall and very heavy! Some even weigh over 200 pounds. That is as heavy as your refrigerator! When pandas are born, their fur is all white and they are only about the length of a grown-up's hand. That's so little! As they get older, they get much, much bigger, and they grow black and white fur. Pandas live in the mountains of China, and they like to eat fruit and a type of

stick called bamboo. You and I have 5 fingers, but Panda bears have 6 fingers on their paws. This helps them climb trees and eat their bamboo sticks. Pandas are really good at climbing, swimming, and taking naps! Panda's love to take naps.

Pandas are known as being one of the friendliest animals. They are very silly, love to play, and almost never get in fights. God wants us to be friendly too, just like the panda bears!
