



# BIBLE LESSON

## DAVID and JONATHAN - WEEK 2

- **1. Memory Verse:** Show your kids the <u>memory verse pictures</u>, and point to each picture as you say the associated words. Have your child repeat the words back to you as you point to each picture. Do this a few times!

# **ACTIVITY 1**

### MEMORY VERSE SEQUENCE PAGE

Print the <u>memory verse sequence page</u>, and cut out the pictures on the side. Help your child tape or glue the pictures onto the correct, numbered squares on the page. Once your child has matched each card, go over the memory verse together. Talk with your child about things they can do that are kind, and have them draw a picture of it in the large box on the page!

**No printer option:** Show your child each picture and say the words associated with the picture as a review! Once you have done this a few times, flip through the pictures and see if they can tell you what each picture means. Consider offering a reward if they can get them all right!
